



## Need help?

You might be able to get some help with your rent from the Council if you are on a low income or receive benefits such as income support, job seekers allowance, incapacity benefit or a retirement pension.

The amount you might get depends on your income, any saving you may have, how much rent you have to pay and how many non-dependent family members live with you – anyone other than children under the age of 17 unless they are in full time education.

If you need help or advice on how to pay your rent or claim housing benefit, contact Ocean Housing straight away. You could also try the Citizens Advice Bureau, the Housing Advice Section of your local Council or a solicitor.
